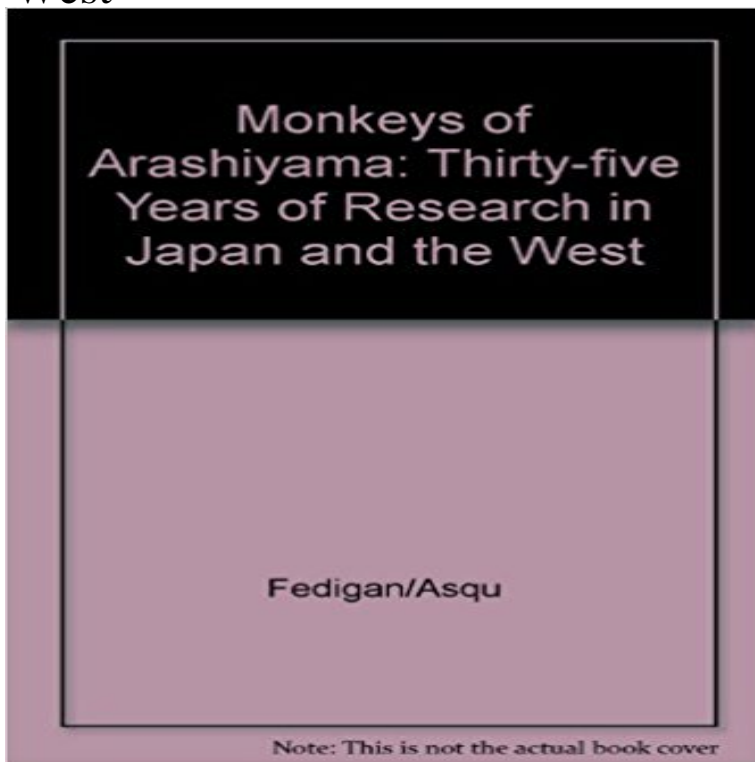


# The Monkeys of Arashiyama: 35 Years of Research in Japan and in the West
