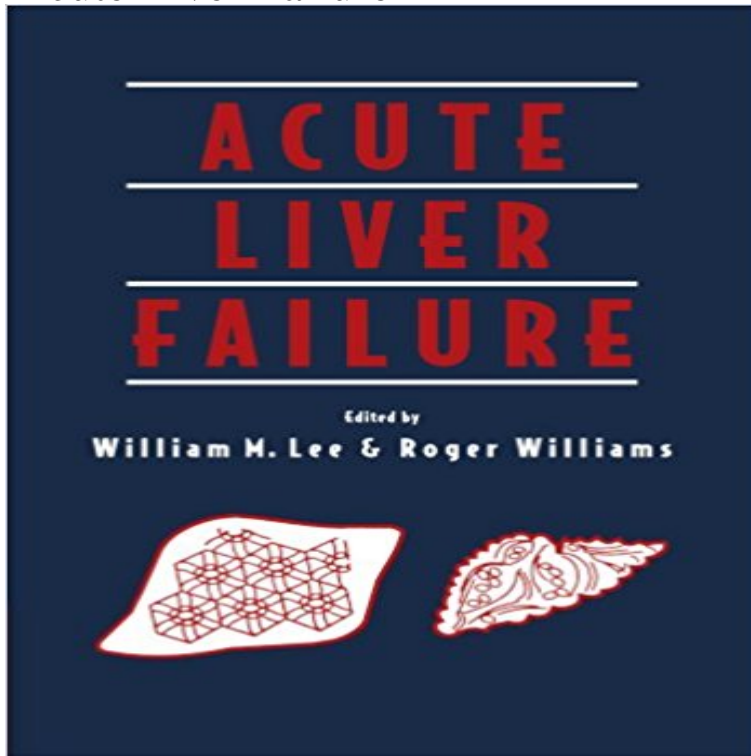


Acute Liver Failure
