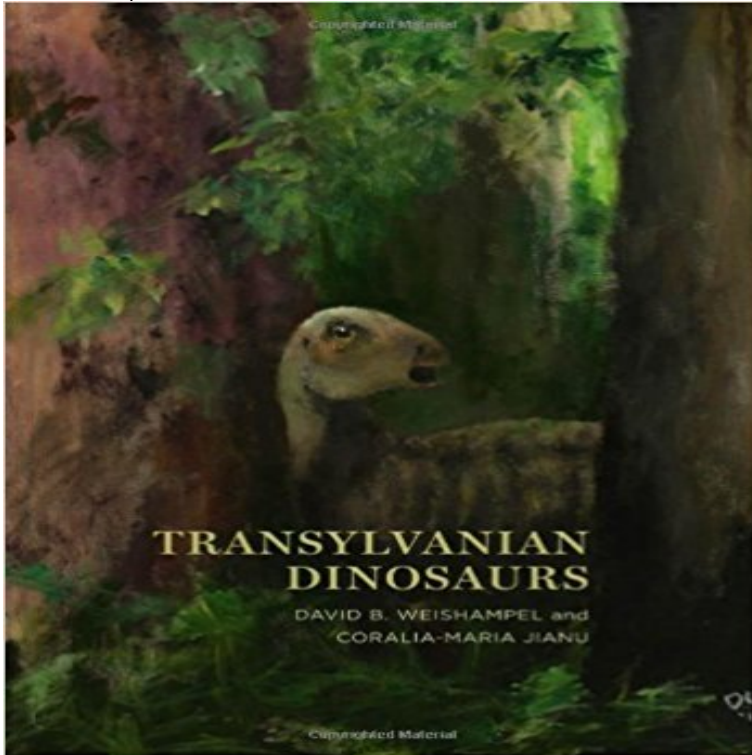


Transylvanian Dinosaurs
