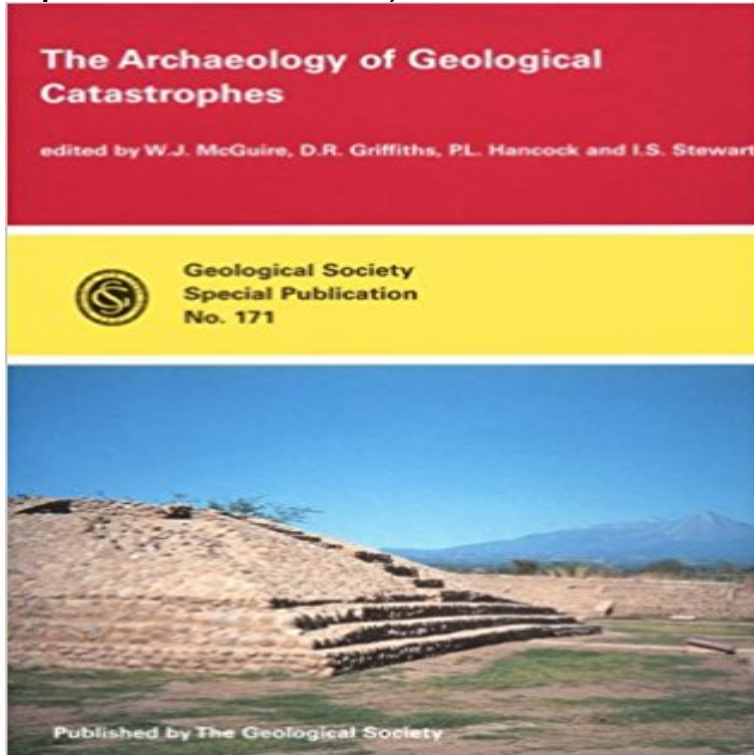


The Archaeology of Geological Catastrophes (Geological Society Special Publication)
