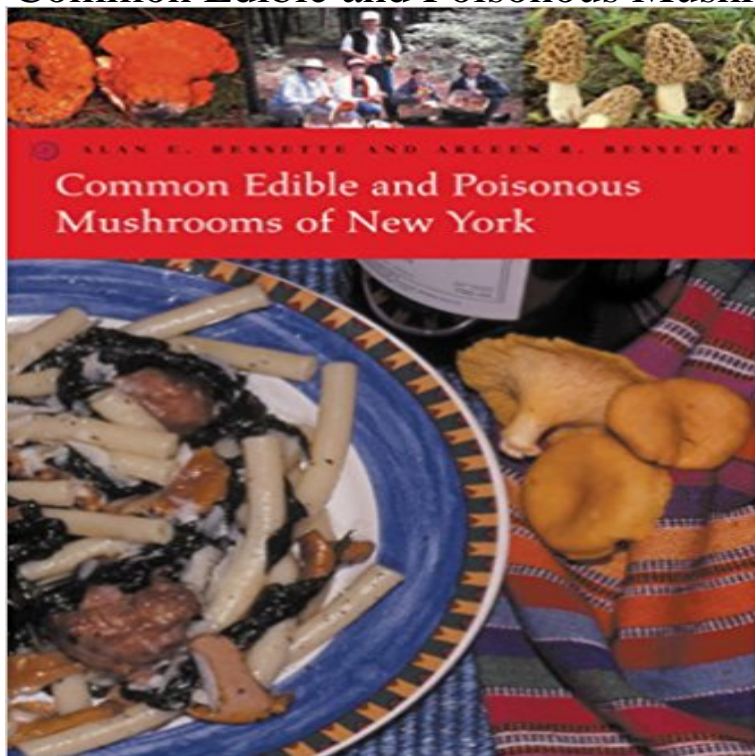


Common Edible and Poisonous Mushrooms of New York
